## Who is eligible to fill out an application to compete?

You just need to be a solid horse person who cares and wants to give a horse a chance to shine and get a home! We will have an adult and youth division, 12 through 17 who has a trainer or solid adult horse person overseeing them at a barn with liability insurance.

### What are all the Details?

- ·Where: Jefferson County Fairgrounds 146 Strishock Ln, Brookville, PA
- ·There will be an in-hand division and a riding division.
- ·This will be a two-day competition, September 14th and 15th, 2024.
- ·You will pick from equine here at Mending Hope Equine Rescue. (Not all horses will be eligible for riding).
- · Biographies of the horses will be posted at the beginning of March, on.
- · Pick up is anticipated at the end of March.
- ·You must post updates every 2 weeks on social media.
- Day one, for both divisions will be an in hand and Free style (3.5 minutes).
- · Day two, Obstacle course in hand or riding followed by an auction for approved adopters.
